Antoine Dutot Museum & Gallery - Main Street, Delaware Water Gap, PA 18327

Museum and gallery established in the area in 1870. One classroom is preserved, as it was last used, not as a "colonial restoration". Come enjoy the audio presentation "Then and Now" as well as exhibits of a bygone era.

From Fernwood North parking lot, Turn right onto Route 209 South. Continue 6 miles to the seventh traffic light. Turn left onto Route 209 south towards Interstate 80. Continue 4 miles. Merge onto Interstate 80 East. Continue 1 mile. Take Exit 310 toward Route 611 South/Delaware Water Gap. Continue 1 mile. Turn left onto Main Street/Route 611 South.

Dorflinger Glass Museum - Fred Suydam Drive, White Mills, PA 18473

Dorflinger, founded in 1865 made lamp chimneys and other utilitarian glass objects and by 1868, was producing fine art. Dorflinger glass was ordered for the White House from the Lincoln administration through the Wilson administration and is still being used in the White House today. Visitors will see over seven hundred pieces of cut, etched, engraved, and gilded glass produced by famed glassmaker Christian Dorflinger in a new museum attached to Dorflinger's 1850 farmhouse.

From Fernwood North parking lot, Turn left onto Route 209 North. Continue for 2 miles. Turn left at blinking light onto Bushkill Falls Road. Stay on Bushkill Falls Road for approximately 12 miles to end. Turn right onto Route 402 North. Follow Route 402 North for 15 miles to end. Turn left onto Route 6 West. Continue for 5.5 miles through the town of Hawley. Continue on Route 6 West to the blinking light in White Mills. Turn right - museum is 0.6 miles on your right.

Stroud Mansion Museum - 900 Main Street, Stroudsburg, PA 18360

Built in 1795 by Jacob Stroud it is the home of the Monroe County Historical Association with the finest Georgian-style architecture. The Mansion houses the Elizabeth D. Walter Library with an extensive and unique collection of family records and genealogical information.

From Fernwood North parking lot, Turn right onto Route 209 South. Continue 6 miles to the seventh traffic light. Turn left onto Route 209 South towards Interstate 80. Continue for 4 miles. Merge onto Interstate 80 West and follow for 2 miles. Take Exit 307 for Route 191. Turn right onto Route 191 North/Broad Street. Go one block. Turn right. Go one block. Turn left onto Main Street. End at Stroud Mansion Museum.

From Fernwood North parking lot, Turn left onto Route 209 South. Continue 2 miles. Turn left at Pocono Indian Museum sign.

From Fernwood North parking lot, Turn right onto Route 209 South. Continue 6 miles to seventh traffic light. Turn left onto Route 209 South. Continue for 4 miles. Merge onto Interstate 80 West. Continue for approximately 4 miles. Take Exit 304 toward Route 33 South/Snydersville. Continue for 7 miles. Take Lehighton Exit onto Business Route 209 South/Sciota. Turn right onto Hamilton Road East/Old Business Route 209. Make left onto Fenner Avenue.

Zane Grey Museum - Route 590, Lackawaxen, PA 18435 - Phone: 570-685-4871

Once the home of this prolific writer, the Zane Grey Museum is a favorite among history and literature buffs. 20 minute long guided tours through the museum are offered. Exhibits include photographs, memorabilia, personal items, manuscripts, and first editions of all of Grey's books.

From Fernwood North parking lot, Turn left onto Route 209 North. Continue for 22 miles. Stay straight at traffic light in the town of Milford onto Route 6 West. Continue to follow Route 6 West for 13 miles. Turn right onto Route 434. Follow for 1.5 miles. At fork in road, Continue left onto Route 590 West. Follow Route 590 West into Lackawaxen. Make a right onto Scenic Drive at the Lackawaxen Inn. End at Zane Grey Museum.
