Perched on Camelback Mountain, Big Pocono State Park is rugged and scenic. A paved, scenic drive encircles the mountaintop and provides a magnificent view of vast portions of Pennsylvania, New York and New Jersey.

From Fernwood north parking lot, Turn right onto Route 209 South. Continue for six miles to seventh traffic light. Turn left onto Route 209 South towards Interstate 80. Continue for 4 miles. Merge onto Interstate 80 West. Take Exit 299. Turn right onto Route 715 North. Continue .2 miles. At traffic light, Turn left onto Sullivan Trail. Turn left onto Camelback Road. Continue straight to park.

From Fernwood north parking lot, Turn right onto Route 209 South. Continue .1 mile. Turn left onto River Road. Continue 1 mile into park.

From Fernwood north parking lot, Turn right onto Route 209 South. Continue for six miles to seventh traffic light. Turn left onto Route 209 South towards Interstate 80. Continue for 4 miles. Merge onto Interstate 80 West. Take Exit 302/Bartonsville. At traffic light, Turn left onto Route 611 North. Continue approximately 2 miles. Turn left onto Rimrock Drive. At fork in road stay right onto North Easton – Belmont Pike Road. Turn right onto Running Valley Road.

From Fernwood north parking lot, Turn left onto Route 209 North. Continue 8-1/2 miles. Turn left onto Briscoe Mountain Road. At stop sign, Turn right onto Emery Road. PEEC is on your right.

These old railroad routes have been given new life as multi-purpose trails for hiking, biking and other activities. Lehigh Gorge Trail - 25 miles along Lehigh River Switchback Trail - 18 miles, Summit Hill to Jim Thorpe.

From Fernwood north parking lot, Turn right onto Route 209 South. Continue for six miles to seventh traffic light. Turn left onto Route 209 South towards Interstate 80. Continue for 4 miles. Merge onto Interstate 80 West. Take 273. Turn left onto PA 940 West / Church Street.. Continue to follow 940 West. Turn left onto Lehigh Gorge Drive which becomes North Lehigh Gorge Road. North Lehigh Gorge Road becomes South Lehigh Gorge Drive. Turn sharp left onto Laurytown Road.

From Fernwood north parking lot, Turn right onto Route 209 South. Continue nine miles to the tenth traffic light. Turn right onto Route 447 North. Stay straight to go onto Route 191 North. Turn left onto Lower Swiftwater Drive. Turn left onto Hulbert Hill Road (Route 314).

From Fernwood north parking lot, Turn left onto Route 209 North. Continue 2 miles to blinking light. Turn left onto Bushkill Falls Road. Continue 12 miles to end. Turn left onto Route 402 South.

73.4 miles of free flowing stream that winds its way through a valley of swiftly changing scenery. Old buildings, remains of a once busy canal, and the oldest existing wire suspension bridge in the US are some of the sights that you will find in the river valley.

From Fernwood north parking lot, Turn left onto Route 209 North. Continue 2 miles to blinking light. Turn left onto Bushkill Falls Road. Continue 12 miles to end. Turn right onto Route 402 North. Continue until end. Turn left onto Route 6 West. Continue through town of Hawley staying on Route 6 West. Turn right onto Route 652 towards Beach Lake. Continue for 7 miles. Turn left onto River Road.
